

WINDMILL DIVISION


A sidestep from the 12-Diamonds

When you have drawn the 12 diamonds (red dotted lines in picture on the left), you usually put designs in the diamonds and don't use your original lines (in black in the drawing on the left).

For the windmill, you will keep the lines from the Basic 8, but not the extra verticals (picture 1 below). The red lines are still just guide lines. DO NOT WAX THESE.

Erase half of every diamond, as shown in picture 2 for ONLY the four diamonds going around the middle.

Connect the points through the center of the crossed lines (picture 3).



Once you have the four windmills around the center, you add the two on the top and bottom.

Extend the lines from the top of the diamonds in a straight line (even though picture 4 makes them look curved) up about half way (tips of the arrows in picture 4).

Then make a line from those points to the top and bottom.

This forms the 5th and 6th windmills.

Once you actually do this, you will find it easier than these written instructions make it appear.
